

# QED - Democratic Management for a Quality Educational Network 2018-EY-PMIP-R1-0022

**The goal of the project:** The development of a network of democratic schools, in which all actors are involved in the elaboration and implementation of the institutional development plan, where diversity represents a positive learning context and the teacher can be a real agent of change.

## Main objectives:

- 1. Improving the management at the three levels: of the County Scool Inspectorate, of the schools and of the class (decisional, informational, organizational, methodological) through decisional transparency, increased institutional capacity and efficiency, in order to increase the quality in education.
- 2. Increasing the quality of the teaching-learning-evaluation process by upgrading the learning approach and the quality assessment system in education.
- 3. Ensuring a stable, equitable, effective and relevant educational system in Dâmboviţa county, compatible with the European one, by enhancing access to quality education and ensuring social equity policies and equal opportunities in order to improve pupils' outcomes.

Ten educational experts (educational experts) participate in three mobilities:

- Building Democratic School Cultures Wergeland, Norway, 4 days of structured course and two days of study visit
- The teacher as a change agent, Newschool As, Norway, 4 days of structured course and one day of job shadowing
- Diverse Society Diverse Classroom, InterCultural Iceland, Iceland, 7 days of structured course

The network of democratic schools will share positive experiences and create an open community to change. Moreover the cooperation in this network will raise the confidence in school inspectors and will improve the management of the SIDC in general.
